Everything around us has a name. Nouns are also called 'naming words'.

<u>Example</u>: Mother, father, cow, pig, table, book, school etc.

Nouns are further divided into two types:

Common Nouns & Proper Nouns

Type 1 : Common Noun :

A common noun is the name given to any person, place, animal or thing.

Example: girl, city, dog, computer etc.

They do not begin with a capital letter.

Type 2 : Proper Noun :

A proper noun is the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.

<u>Example</u>: Nancy, India, Tommy, HP computers etc.

The followings are also called 'Proper Nouns':

Days of the week -> Sunday, Monday

Months of the year -> March, April etc.

All proper nouns begin with capital letters.
