<u>C.W</u> -> <u>Nouns</u> :-

Everything around us has a name.

Nouns are also called 'naming words'

<u>Ex</u>: mother, father, cow, pig, table, book, school, etc.

Nouns are further divided into two types :-

Common nouns and proper nouns

Type 1 :- Common noun ->

A common noun is the name given to any person, place, animal or thing.

Ex :- Girl, city, dog, computer, etc.

They do not begin with a capital letter.

Type 2 :- Proper noun ->

A proper noun is the name of a particular person, place, animal or thing.

<u>Ex</u>:- Nancy, India, Tommy, HP computers, etc.

The followings are also called

'Proper Nouns':-

Days of the week -> Sunday, Monday.

Months of the week -> March, April, etc.

All proper nouns begin with

Capital letters.
